Voting and Photo ID

A new photo ID requirement for voting in Virginia takes effect July 1, 2014. Most of us have a driver's license or other photo ID, but you may know someone who doesn't and would like to know how to get a valid photo ID.

Efforts to register voters, inform voters about the photo ID requirement, and help registered voters who lack a valid photo ID to obtain one will occur in the lead-up to the November 4 Election Day. During Northern Virginia Voter Registration Week, September 23–30, the League of Women Voters of the Fairfax Area will host tables at libraries, festivals, and other sites.

Members of the AAUW Fairfax City Branch are encouraged to volunteer to assist at a LWV voter registration event. Information about the new photo ID law and voter registration events will be available online as the summer progresses. See www.lwv-fairfax.org,
